

The SAME Bible that teaches us:

That God made all of creation
That He made man in His own image
That God gave the commandments saying
That you shall not murder, you shall not steal
That God took on human nature in Jesus Christ
That Christ was born of a virgin in the town of Bethlehem
That Christ was crucified and rose from the grave
That we receive eternal life when we believe in Him
That we should be forgiving to others
That we should not be covetous or greedy
That we should care for the poor, the widow and the orphan
That man should love his wife as his own flesh

ALSO teaches us:

That a wife is to submit to her own husband and obey him
That she should greatly honor him
That she should bear children and keep the home
That she is to be silent and submissive in the churches, and may not have authority or teach over men
That she is to be modest in heart and in appearance
That she should possess chastity, meekness, shamefacedness
That the wife should emulate Sarah, who called her husband lord
That her meekness shows the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit
And that this is pleasing to the Lord

It's ALL the same Bible, and that's what it teaches. Please notice every teaching above can be found in the New Testament, in case there is some question as to which truths continue into the New Covenant.

If your heart rebels at hearing the things in the **RIGHT** column and not the left, consider that rebellion to be from the flesh, and not the spirit. The spirit rejoices in the things of God!

“Lord” in 1 Peter 3:6 is the Greek word kyrios. This is the same Greek word commonly used for God. It is a high honor, and this is what Sarah called Abraham.
